


With just a small group of voters closely following news about AI, the broader public is reflexively skeptical and concerned about the technology

For companies wading into this space, the data shows that proactive efforts to familiarize and educate the public about the opportunities presented by the technology will be paramount




How closely have you been following news stories about artificial intelligence (AI) technology?





FAMILIARITY WITH GENERATIVE AI TOOLS LIKE CHATGPT IS STILL GENERALLY LOW


How familiar would you say you are with ChatGPT, which is an AI-based computer program that can generate humanlike text responses to questions and prompts?

[IF FAMILIAR WITH CHATGPT] Which of the following best describes your interactions with ChatGPT?




Those who have personally used ChatGPT are more likely to be:

Do you think having machines with the ability to mimic human language will help or hurt human beings' quality of life?




[IF FAMILIAR WITH CHATGPT] Do you believe the answers provided by ChatGPT are trustworthy or are they untrustworthy?









COMPANIES SEEKING TO INCREASE THEIR USAGE OF AI MUST ADDRESS THE TRUST DEFICIT




Based on what you know or have heard about generative AI, do you think that companies should ban generative AI tools like ChatGPT, Google Bard, and Dall-E at work?


Should content creators (such as authors, songwriters, artists, or social media personalities) be compensated for their work if it is used by AI to generate a new work?
